This simple statement expresses just how valuable Breeding Manager, Judi Boggs-Anderson, is to Team Midwest. Raised in a family of horsemen, Judi started working with her brothers conditioning show horses more than a quarter century ago. Since 2001, she's been in charge of the immensely important and ever-growing breeding operation at Midwest Station II.

Today, Judi oversees mare care, as well as keeping the foaling and breeding records that are so essential to the effective management of many of the world's most sought after and important stallions. Midwest represents 10 to 15 stallions at any given time, maintains approximately 80 mares in residence, and together with it's affiliates services more than 400 mares each season (the lion's share via shipped semen that travels the world over). Yet even with these numbers, Judi knows every mare and stallion —and owner— on a first name basis.
